The church was opened on October 16, 1817

The church was originally built of wood. The farmers built it after 1655 with their own efforts and donated funds

This is a central church type classicism octagonal stone building with a bell tower on one side and an oak interior

The construction of the church cost 7,800 gold rubles, most of which was donated by the father of the magistrate - the rich man of Moscow, Aleksandrs Vasilievich Savelyevs

10. DRUSTI LUTHERAN CHURCH

The church was built in the Empire style based on the example of the Pievolga German colonies

The altar of the church was decorated in 1898. Otto Donner von Richter painting "The Ascension of Christ"

In 1901, a 10 register organ built by organ master Emil Martin was installed in the church
